Today we have looked at different aerial photographs. They have been taken by a satellite in space. We have talked about the different features we can see in the photos too.

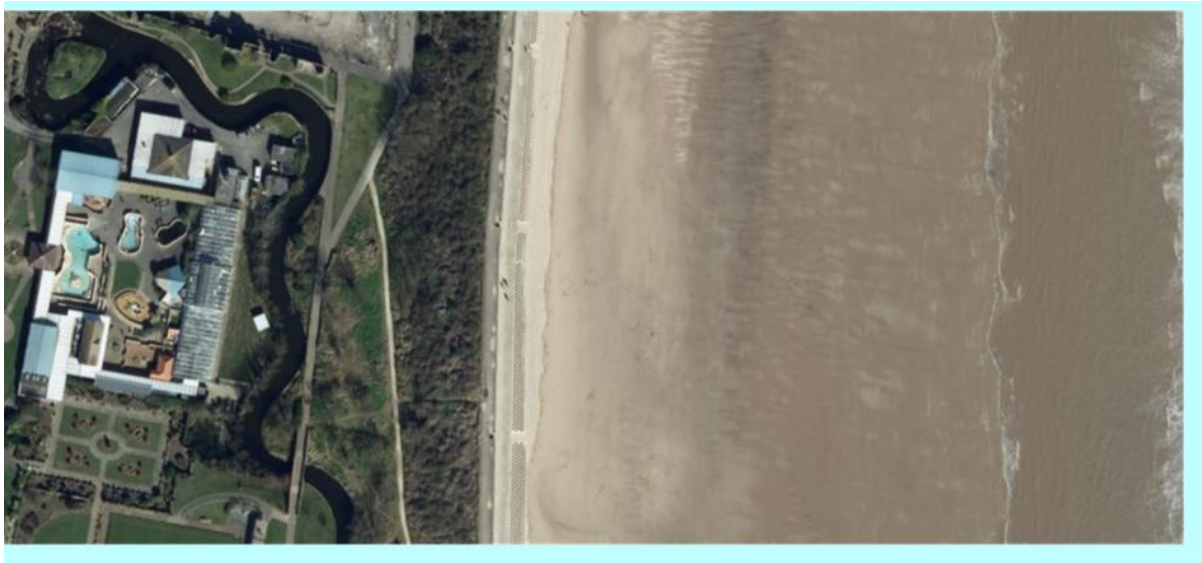
I would like you to write about the different features that you can see in the photographs. Some you may recognise because they are of Boston. Can you find our school?

I would like you to describe both human and physical features and I will write a reminder of what each one is below. What is there? Why was it built? Or was it there naturally?

**Human Feature** - A human feature is an object or thing that has been made or created by humans. E.g. roads, house etc.

**Physical Feature** - A physical feature is something that was there naturally and was not created by a person. E.g. tree, beach, hills etc.

In this picture I can see a sandy beach and the deep ocean which are both physical features. They are physical features because they are there naturally.

I can see a swimming pool. The swimming pool is a human feature because it was built by a person.

I can see lots of roads in this picture. Roads were made by people so they are human features. Roads are used so people can travel and get to different places.
