Year 6 are going on an educational visit to Stibbington Centre on Wednesday 7th December, as part of their Evacuation Day Britain at War topic. We will leave school at **8.40am** (children to be in school for **8.30am prompt**) and will return to school at approximately 4.00pm.

Your child will be acting the part of a real child who was evacuated to Stibbington and should be dressed in 1940s style for the day - dig out the knitted pullovers and cotton dresses/cardigans, hair ribbons and Brylcream!

The children will require a packed lunch (please ensure there are no glass bottles or fizzy drinks). Please could you also ensure your child has a drink of water, all placed in a backpack.

If you have already ordered a hot school meal for your child on this day, please remember to phone Ideal School Meals on 01522 246424 and cancel it, in order to receive a refund or exchange for a packed lunch. If you would like Ideal School Meals to provide a packed lunch, you will need to place an order through Ideal School Meals before Monday 28th November.

As this is an educational visit we ask that you make a voluntary contribution of £22.30 towards the cost of travel and entry fee for this trip. We appreciate that this is a voluntary contribution, however, if insufficient contributions are received, this visit may not be able to proceed. The cost of the coach hire has increased significantly pre-Covid. We have set up the option to pay for this trip online via your ParentPay account, (we cannot accept cash payments). If you require assistance using your ParentPay account please contact the school office. Should this present any problems please have a word with me as soon as possible. Your support in using ParentPay will help the school enormously. Did you know, you can pay any amount into ParentPay weekly/monthly to save for any upcoming trips/events, this is then held in your ParentPay account until you need to make a payment.

If your child suffers from travel sickness, please notify your child's teacher and administer anti-sickness medication before arriving at school.
