This week in maths we have looked at fact families and applying our place value knowledge to look at whole numbers and parts of those whole numbers. We have applied mathematical reasoning using addition and subtraction to write facts using 2-digit and 1-digit numbers.

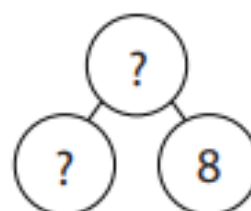
Look at the fact family below.

$$\begin{array}{ll} 7 + 8 = 15 & 15 - 7 = 8 \\ 15 = 7 + 8 & 8 = 15 - 7 \\ 8 + 7 = 15 & 15 - 8 = 7 \\ 15 = 8 + 7 & 15 = 7 - 8 \end{array}$$

Spot the mistake and correct it.

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Look at the part-whole model.



The whole is greater than 10, but less than 15.

What could the missing part and whole be? Find all the possibilities.

Part	Whole

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Ben has two fish bowls.

He has 11 fish in total.

There is at least 1 fish in each bowl.

How many fish could be in each bowl?

Find five possibilities.

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Write a problem to describe the fact family below.

$$\begin{array}{ll} 6 + 8 = 14 & 14 - 6 = 8 \\ 14 = 6 + 8 & 8 = 14 - 6 \\ 8 + 6 = 14 & 14 - 8 = 6 \\ 14 = 8 + 6 & 6 = 14 - 8 \end{array}$$

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
