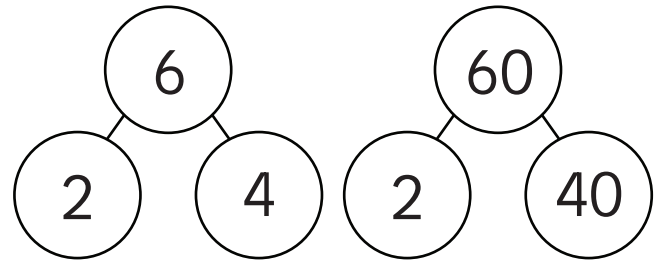


Which is the odd one out?

- $1 + 1 = 2$

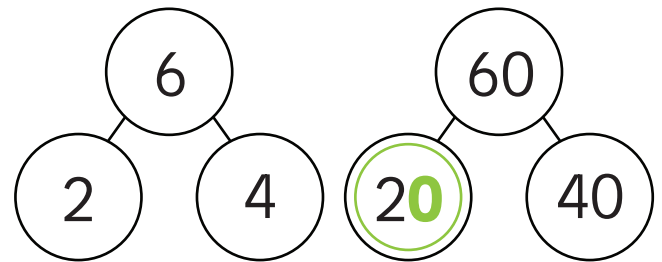
Are these statements true or false?
