Religious Vocabulary

Word	Definition
Baptism	Baptism is a Sacrament. It is a meeting point with God where the person is freed from Original Sin. Through Baptism, the person becomes a Christian.
John the Baptist	He was the last prophet of the Old Covenant who devoted his life to preparing the way for Jesus.
miracle	An extraordinary event that is so unusual it is considered a sign of God's power.
parable	This is a short story that includes a moral or spiritual message. Jesus used parables to teach people about God.
temptation	When someone wants something or does something that they know they should not have or do.
sin	An action that is a wrong choice and separates us from God. A sin can often hurt us or other people.
sorrow	A feeling of deep sadness or regret.
forgiveness	Letting go of cross and angry feelings towards someone who has hurt or upset them.
Reconciliation	Christians come to Jesus in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. People confess their sins to the priest and are forgiven in Jesus' name.
