


Self-Portraits

Portrait:

A portrait is a painting, photo or drawing of a person.



Self-portrait:

A self-portrait is a portrait that an artist creates of themselves.




Self-portrait, Vincent van Goah, 1889

Collage:

A collage is a picture that had been made from different materials being cut and glued together.





Pablo Picasso:

Pablo Picasso was a famous artist. He was known for drawing portraits. He liked using different colours in his painting to portray how people are feeling.

One of his most famous techniques was the use of 'cubism' in his portraits.

Cubism:

Cubism is when the artist paints an object, like a bottle, from lots of different angles all in the same picture. So you see the front, the back and the sides of the bottle at the same time.







Glossary:

Collage: A picture made up of different, smaller parts cut and glued together.



Cubism: When the artist paints an object from lots of different angles all in the same picture.

Facial Feature: A part of the face, such as the nose, eyes, mouth, ears or cheeks.
