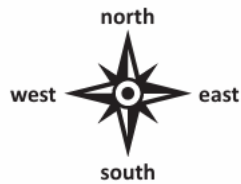


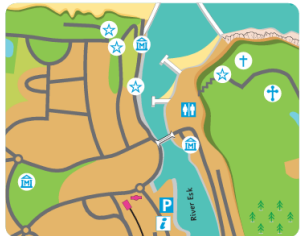

How do maps and the weather help us understand our world?

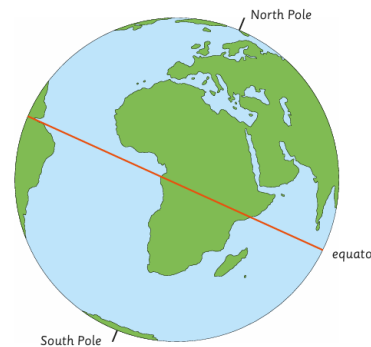
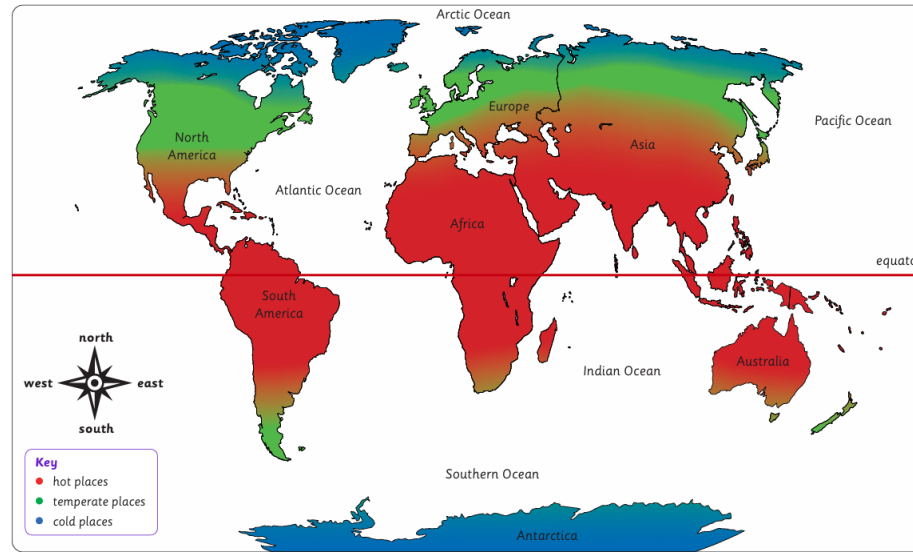


A compass is a tool for finding and showing direction. It has four cardinal points – North, East, South and West.

A map is a drawing of an area of land or sea, usually drawn from above. Map symbols represent human and physical features. A key is a list that explains what the symbols mean.

The equator is an imaginary line around the Earth. Places near the equator are hotter, and places further away from the equator are colder. Temperate areas are between these hot and cold climates. A temperate climate is mild and not very hot or cold.
