Animals:

Animals are living creatures.

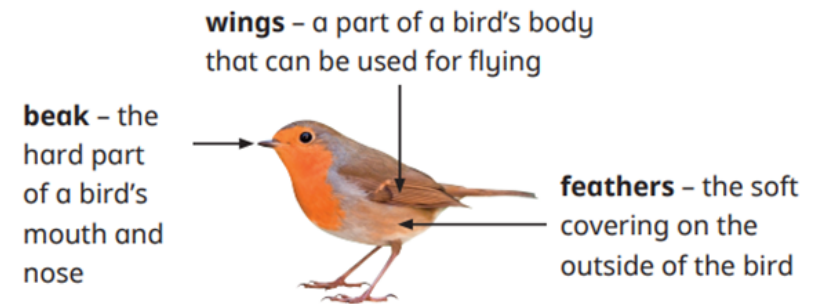
They can be sorted into different groups of animals based on their features: mammals, birds, amphibians, reptiles and fish.

A wild animal is an animal that is not looked after by humans.

Pets are animals that are looked after by humans.

Bird:

An animal with feathers, wings and a beak.



Mammal:

An animal with fur or hair on its body.



Amphibian:

An animal that lives on land and in water.



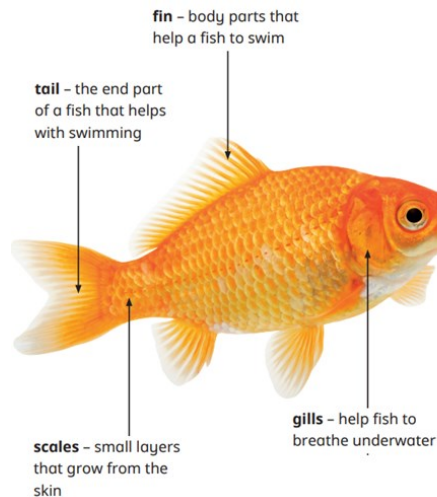
Reptile:

An animal that has dry scales.



Fish:

An animal that lives in water which usually has fins, scales and gills.

Amphibian: An animal that lives on land and in water.

Bird: An animal that has feathers, wings and a beak.

Fish: An animal that lives in water and usually has fins, scales and gills.

Fur: The fine, soft hair found on different animals.

Mammal: An animal with fur or hair on its body.

Pet: An animal that is looked after by humans.

Reptile: An animal that has dry scales.

Wild: An animal that is not looked after by humans.
