







Deciduous tree:

A deciduous tree loses its leaves in autumn.

Horse chestnut, sycamore and oak trees are all deciduous.



Evergreen tree:

An evergreen tree keeps its leaves all year round.

Holly and pine trees are evergreen.

Glossary

Deciduous: A type of tree that loses its leaves in autumn.

Evergreen: A tree that keeps its leaves all year round.

Flower: The part of a plant that is often brightly coloured.





Garden plant: A plant that has been chosen by humans to grow in their garden.



Leaf: The flat, usually green part of a plant.

Petal: The outside parts of a flower.

Root: The underground part of a plant.



Stem: The upright part of a plant, which is usually green.

Wildflower: A plant that has not been chosen by humans to grow in their garden.
