Compass

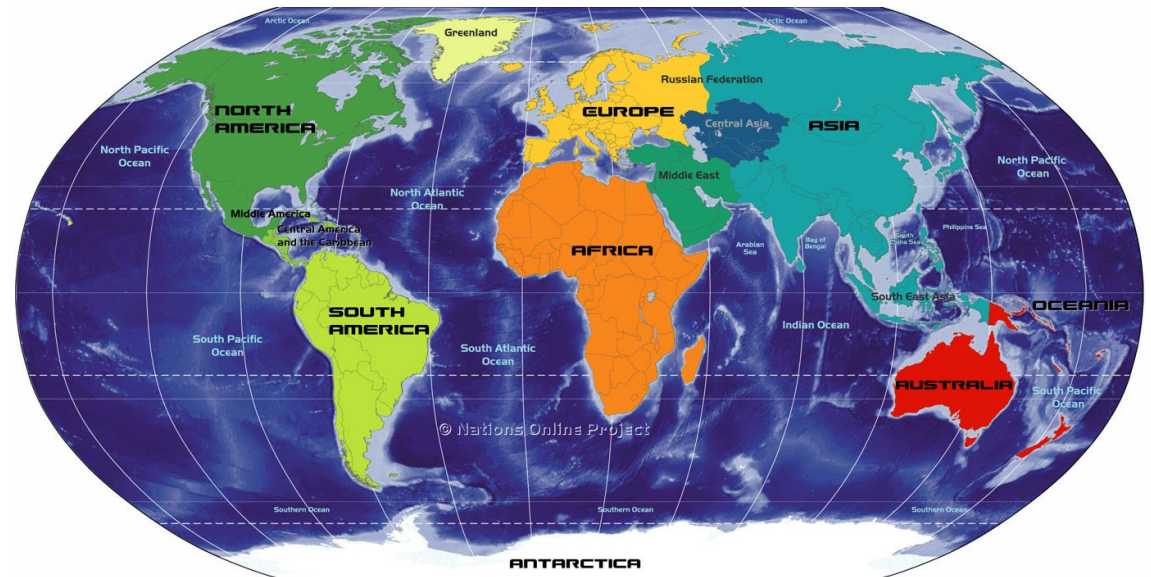
There are 4 main directions on a compass. North, East, South and West.

Glossary

Ocean - A large body of salt water.

Continent - A large mass of land made up of lots of different countries.

Compass— Helps show the direction you are travelling in.

Atlas— A book which contains different maps of the world including the continents, countries and oceans.

Equator—A line that divides the Northern and Southern Hemispheres.

Map— A diagram of land or sea.

Country—A nation with it's own Government.

An Atlas can help you find different information out about the world. Inside it contains different maps of the world such as maps labelling the oceans and continents of the world or maps of the equator with the countries surrounding them.
