

Mammals



Mammals have fur or hair on their bodies.

Birds



Birds have feathers, wings and beaks.

Fish



Fish are animals that live in water.

Fish need air, water, food and shelter to survive.

Fish have gills that they use to breathe.

Amphibian



Amphibians live on land and in water.

Amphibians do not have scales on their bodies.

Some amphibians have webbed feet.

Amphibians need air, water, food and shelter to survive.

Reptile



Reptiles have dry scales on their bodies.

They need air, water, food and shelter to survive.


Reptiles need direct heat to survive.

Glossary

Feathers – The soft covering on the outside of birds.



Beak – The hard, pointed part of a bird's mouth and nose.



Insectivore – An animal that eats insects, worms and spiders.



Fur – The fine, soft hair found on different animals.



Carnivore – An animal that eats other animals.



Herbivore – An animal that eats plants.



Omnivore – An animal that eats plants and other animals.
