October 2023 Advent-Parent Consultation Feedback

- 59 responses to the RSHE parent consultation questionnaire
- 95% of parents understand what their child will be taught and when.
- 95% of parents are comfortable with the Catholic ethos of the programme.
- 98% of parents understand and accept that their role is as the 'first educator' of their child on matters related to teaching human sexuality.
- 97% of parents trust school's judgment in delivering this programme.
- 90% of parents approve of their child learning the names of external genitalia in KS1.
- 92% of parents are happy for their child to be taught about sexual intimacy in Year 6, in a way that is respectful of Catholic beliefs.
- 95% of parents understand how to submit a request to withdraw their child from the elements of sex education that are not taught as part of the compulsory national science curriculum.
- 36% of parents would like to be involved in reviewing the school's RSHE policy.
- Majority of parents would like more information regarding RSHE via the newsletter and a list of books/resources that could be used at home to support them
- 46% of parents would be interested in attending an information session to find out more about RSHE at St Mary's for Year 5 and Year 6 parents.
